# **Assignment and course reports**

# To view an Assignment Report,

- Select the applicable assignment.
- 2 Click the ellipsis : at the top right.
- Select "View Report."

## To view a Rubric Report,

- Select the applicable assignment.
- Click the ellipsis : at the top right.
- 3 Select either "Download Instructor Rubric Report (CSV)" or "Download Student Rubric Report (CSV)" as applicable. (Please note that these options will only appear if a rubric has been enabled on the assignment and one or more sessions have been graded with the rubric.)
- Import the file into your favorite spreadsheet tool.

#### To view a Course Report,

1 Click the ellipsis button : next to the course name and select "View Report."



Reports summarize the recording and commenting activity for each participant. Below is a description of each section:

Yellow columns

The yellow columns relate to the participant's *critiquing* activity. (This is contextual, depending on whether you selected to view a course or assignment report.)

- # Videos Critiqued: Number of videos the user has given feedback on.
- Total Comments: Total number of comments the user has entered on all videos.
- **Avg. Comment Length:** Average word length of the user's comments. This is a computed average and may vary slightly from the actual word count. It's intended to give a general idea of comment length.

#### Green columns

The green columns relate to the participant's *recording* activity. (This is contextual, depending on whether you selected to view a course or assignment report.)

- # Videos Presented: Number of videos where the user is a Presenter.
- **Total Score:** The presenter's overall score out of total points possible (average of all evaluations if more than one is given).
- Markers: A summary of all markers left on the presenter's recordings.

# User expanded view

This section shows specifics for each video submitted by the chosen presenter.

- **Presenter(s):** Shows all presenters on the videos submitted by this student. (Usually just the student, but for group submissions, there may be multiple presenters.)
- **Assignment:** Shows the assignment this video belongs to.
- **Date:** Shows when the video was submitted.
- **Duration:** Shows the duration of the video.
- **Final Score:** Shows the final score on the video.
- Markers: Shows a count of all markers left on a video.
