The degree program is a joint venture of the Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs, the Monte Ahuja College of Business, and the School of Communication.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The program is designed to utilize previous college coursework and accommodate students who have completed an associate's degree. Students must have a minimum of 60 semester hours completed (junior standing) and meet CSU admission requirements, including a GPA of 2.0 or higher. To be considered for admission, applicants must satisfy CSU's general education requirements or have completed the Ohio Transfer Module and the university foreign language requirement.
