

5-Year Bachelor of Arts in Nonprofit Administration + Master of Nonprofit Administration & Leadership

The 5-Year BA+MNAL is a fast-track program designed for high-performing undergraduates in the BA in Urban Services Administration program. Students can jump-start their careers as professionals in the nonprofit sector by accelerating the completion of two degrees.

Admission Requirements

Undergraduate students must submit an application for admission to the MNAL Program through the Office of Graduate Admissions. A complete application is comprised of the application form or on-line application, the \$30.00 application fee, official Graduate Record Exam scores, and two letters of recommendation from faculty.

Minimum qualifications: 90 hours earned, grade point average of 3.25 or better, GRE scores at the 40th percentile (verbal and quantitative combined) and an Analytical Writing score of 4.0 or better, plus completion of core competencies (UST 300, UST 302, UST 404, NAD 451) or their transfer equivalents with a B or better.
