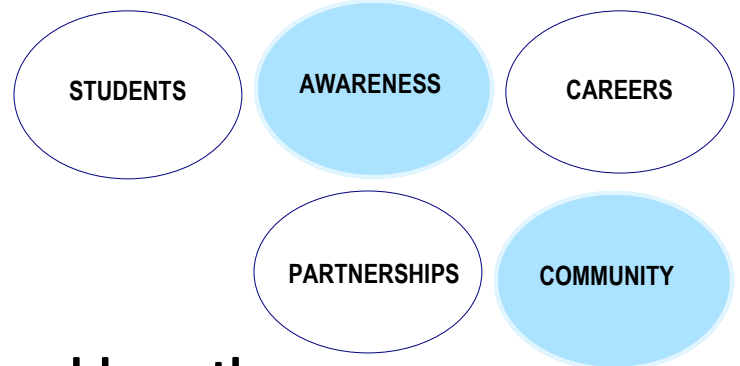


Disparities to Equity Series
