### **Cleveland State's Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs Call for Entries "Envisioning Cleveland" Photo Exhibition**

As part of the 30th Anniversary celebration of the Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs, the Center for Civic Education is hosting a photo exhibit *Envisioning Cleveland*. A call is being made for photos, reflecting the theme *Envisioning Cleveland*, of images of Cleveland that convey the hope and excitement for our future as a city.

The photo exhibit is open to all residents in Northeast Ohio. Photographers of any age are eligible. No more than five photos from each entrant will be accepted. The exhibit will run from September 7 through December 31, 2007. There is no entry fee and entries may be submitted via mail or e-mail. The deadline is Monday, August 13, 2007. The deadline will not be extended and late submissions will not be accepted.
