THE TRIPPLICITY PROJECT: AN EXHIBITION OF PHOTOGRAPHS AND COMMENTARY BY G.M. DONLEY

Cleveland State University's Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs will present "The Triplexity Project" – an exhibition of photographs and commentary by G.M. Donley opening in the Thomas F. Campbell, Ph.D., Exhibition Gallery on Thursday, June 1, from 4:00 until 6:00 p.m. The exhibit and opening reception with the artist is free and open to the public, and will be held in the College's Glickman-Miller Hall, located at 1717 Euclid Avenue.

The Triplexity Project employs photography to creatively present urban spaces. The works, triplets of images in black and white, roughly allude to what a person sees when glancing back and forth while in a space. Each depicts a particular place over the course of half a minute or so, covering 180 degrees of view. Donley asks people to look at the images and share their impressions. The exhibition presents the images and transcribed commentary, along with a second batch of images that visitors will be able to write their own thoughts about.

An editor, writer and graphic designer for the Cleveland Museum of Art since 1991, G.M. Donley's pursuits have often combined the verbal and the visual. Since the 1980s, he has been active as a freelance writer, designer and photographer. He has shown photography-based art in numerous exhibitions around the Cleveland area. He is president, and a founding board member, of Heights Arts and is a founding board member of FutureHeights – both nonprofit community groups in Cleveland Heights. In 1999, he earned a Master of Science in Urban Studies from Cleveland State University's Levin College of Urban Affairs. He received his undergraduate English degree from Oberlin College in 1983.

The photos, by Donley from his "Triplexity" project, will be on display until Saturday, September 30. Gallery hours are 9:00 a.m. through 9:00 p.m. daily and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
