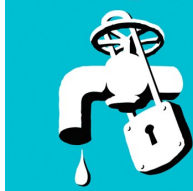
Saturday, April 4th at 7:00pm - The Water Front:

While corporations urge local governments to privatize municipal water, communities around the world are organizing to ensure affordable access to this life sustaining resource.

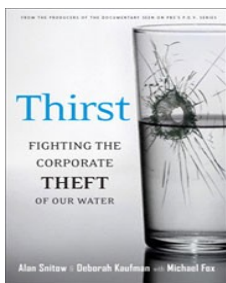
