

40 Hour OSHA Hazardous Materials HAZWOPER Technician

Course Description:

This forty-hour course is specifically designed for workers who are involved in clean-up operations, voluntary clean-up operations, emergency response operations, and storage, disposal, or treatment of hazardous substances or uncontrolled hazardous waste sites. The course requirements are based upon the (OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 for private sector) and (NFPA for public sector) programs. Participants must successfully complete hands-on scenarios and a written test.
