

4 Hour Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)

Course Description:

The RCRA class will teach you how to comply with the EPA regulations and requirements. In addition, you will learn how to read the Code of Federal Regulations and learn where all the important sections are in the regulations. The course will discuss the differences between "Satellite Accumulation" and 90-day storage requirements. You will also learn the different ways that a waste can become hazardous and what those different letter codes mean.

Course Objectives:

- Understanding the definitions and meaning of Hazardous Waste Identification
- Understanding Generator Requirements including thresholds and requirements
- Understanding the requirements of the Hazardous Waste Manifest
- Understanding the basics of the Used Oil Regulations
- Understanding the basics of the Universal Waste Regulations- USEPA and OEPA

Who should attend?

The Environmental Protection Agency requires that any employee involved in the following activities must be trained on an annual basis:

- Industrial, warehouse and maintenance personnel
- Drivers and carriers of dangerous goods
- Safety and supervisory personnel
- Employees involved in shipping and receiving
