Application Procedure

Purpose: The *Campbell-Steinbacher Fellows Endowment* was established to provide scholarships and/or fellowships for senior level students at Cleveland State University within the undergraduate programs at the Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs. It is the wish of the donor that the Campbell-Steinbacher Fellow be engaged in applied research and/or outreach on the urban environment and that the Campbell-Steinbacher Fellow(s) have the opportunity to work with a professor in an experiential research activity.

Guidelines: Open to seniors in one of the Levin College undergraduate programs. The fellowship will be awarded to full-time students only and will provide full-time tuition and fees and a stipend for the duration of two semesters, i.e., senior year of college. The fellow will be engaged in research for 20 hours per week with a faculty member of the department.
