2010 EPA Greater Research Opportunities (GRO) Fellowships are available to undergraduates entering their last two years of study in fall 2010 semester.

Application deadline: December 10, 2009

The fellowship will enable you to continue your studies in an environmentally-related field. It requires that you orient your junior/senior years toward coursework with the required purpose of pollution prevention and/or control in specific areas including Environmental Science, and interdisciplinary areas such as Urban Planning, or Social Sciences and Decision Making.

- Eligible students will receive support for their junior and senior years of study and for a required summer internship at an EPA facility. Each intern must complete a summer project designed to complement and enhance the training received under the fellowship program.
- The fellowship provides up to \$19,250 per year of academic support and up to \$8,000 of internship support for summer internship, for a combined total of up to \$46,500.
