The Public Safety Management major is designed to equip public safety officials with additional management and communication skills to address the needs of their urban constituents. It provides an in-depth study of community safety needs and problems, as well as analytical tools for addressing injustice for those living and working in urban settings.

The program is designed for pre-career and active public safety personnel. Students learn about policy development and, response strategies for emergency situations, and prepare to be effective leaders in public safety organizations.

The United States Fire Administration and the National Fire Academy for educational excellence recognize the Cleveland State University Public Safety Management program. The program contains an optional Fire and Emergency Service Administration track, which includes six courses that are the base requirements of the National Fire Academy, Higher Education program.
