

Edwin B. Hogan Memorial Scholarship

A \$5,000 scholarship presented to a student of Black/African descent in the civil engineering, architecture, surveying, or planning fields with a focus on community involvement.

Ed Hogan was an influential African American lobbyist who had a significant and lasting effect on regulatory, legislative, and executive laws on behalf of clients. His tradition of excellence in government relations spanned more than thirty years. One of Ed's most impactful characteristics was his ability to build long-term collaborations and bridge gaps by helping people make connections that proved to be mutually beneficial. Ed's profound success hinged on his philosophy: "It is one thing to have a long list of contacts, but knowing how to link people is key."

Throughout his career, Ed was a strong advocate for what he recognized as the need to educate more young African Americans about careers in lobbying. Through his involvement with the 100 Black Men of Central Ohio, Ed was involved in a mentoring program that included government affairs. "We want to encourage young people to get involved," he said, "because in the political process you're either a player or a victim." He received numerous accolades, awards, and commendations and served a number of organizations, including Maryhaven, Alvis House, Muscular Dystrophy Association, and the Columbus Metropolitan Area Community Action Organization (CMAO). However, when asked his greatest accomplishment, he responded, "Adopting an elementary school and receiving the Golden Ruler Award from the Columbus Public School System."
