Drake in 2001 under the Ohio Center for the Advancement of Women in Public Service, the mentoring program pairs Levin College students with community professionals in leadership positions within the public or nonprofit sectors. Mentors provide guidance as students examine career choices during the academic year.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Levin College juniors, seniors, and graduate students are eligible to apply. Space is limited.
