- Agree to work in partnership with the College's dean and advancement staff to help the College increase financial support for our priorities.
- Provide or identify internship opportunities, student mentoring, and job placement whenever possible and appropriate.
- Attend a majority of the scheduled Visiting Committee meetings.

TERM:

Appointment to the Visiting Committee will be for one, three-year term. A Member is eligible for reappointment to a second, three-year term after which a Member will be eligible for emeritus status to the Committee.
